

# PGY2 PHARMACY RESIDENCY PROGRAM IN INFECTIOUS DISEASES

The residency is a 12-month, ASHP accreditation candidate, post-graduate program that begins around July 1 annually. We accept one resident yearly. **Application deadline is Jan. 15.**
